

### ***“Statement about Homosexuality”***

This is the essence of our accumulated information on homosexuality. The data evolved during the 1990s from numerous admissions of gay men, lesbians, and bisexuals with whom the author and his clairvoyant co-researcher were interacting.

The admissions were confirmed in the over 50 clairvoyant psychological case study readings subsequently done by Jean Mastellone. Jean’s homosexual readings are penetrating reports that show what Jean clairvoyantly observed in the subconscious of homosexuals and bisexuals of varied socio-economic-ethnic-religious background. Her observations reveal key missing (hidden) pieces of the "homosexuality puzzle."

- Fears, misunderstanding, and stigma in relation to homosexuality are claimed to be the main reasons why so many gays, lesbians, and bisexuals suffer low self-image. This is not true. It is true and no one can deny that gay men and lesbians are banned from serving openly in the U.S. military, that child custody decisions tend to judge homosexuals as unfit parents, that gay and lesbian teens are often ridiculed and humiliated in school. It is also sadly true that hate crimes are on the rise, and that most professionals and corporate employees are fearful of identifying themselves as gay.
  
- Homophobia and the accompanying prejudice, discrimination, harassment, injustice, prohibition, and, in

some societies, severe punishments, are shameful reactions that, unfortunately, are still with us.

- The research findings that we will be presenting indicate "social stigma" and "civil injustices" are not the essential source of the low self-esteem, depression, substance abuse, suicide rate, or other mental and emotional instability and pain suffered by the typical homosexual or bisexual. The homosexuals and bisexuals with whom we interacted admitted to knowing this. We suspect that every homosexual and bisexual knows that there are additional and more significant factors that account for their deepest pain not currently on being placed on the table. The true reasons for their low self-esteem and psychological problems originate inside them. The bottom-line cause is not outside them.
  
- To understand the bottom-line cause, one needs to go back in time to a homosexual's family environment. The cause has to do with wrong choices he or she made during childhood in reaction to the ongoing sexually abusive and excessively controlling wrong choices of both their parents (or parent substitutes). The selfish reactions of homosexuals and bisexuals define their behavior, symptoms, and pain.
  
- In 1973, the American Psychiatric Association's Board of Trustees removed homosexuality from its Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, Second Edition (DSM II). These experts were challenged and

pressured (rightly so) into conceding that homosexuality did not meet the criteria to be considered a "mental illness." We fully agree that homosexuality is not an "illness" in the biological sense. Again, homosexual behavior is, in fact, an extremely selfish reaction, which is what all mental, emotional, behavioral, and sexual disorders are.

- Almost twenty years later, in 1992, the American Psychiatric Association declared "homosexuality per se implied no impairment in judgment, stability, reliability, or general social or vocational capabilities." This grossly irresponsible medical position has done great harm to gays. It is a form of negative agreement that reinforces the denial and dishonesty of most gays. It helps create an airless tomb from which there is no apparent reason to attempt escape. If there is nothing "wrong," then there is nothing anyone should be doing.
  
- The American Psychiatric Association now views homosexuality and sexual orientation in general as "non-problematic" behavior. Therefore, working to understand or alter sexual orientation is not an appropriate goal of psychiatric treatment. Psychiatrists will treat gays with coming out concerns, relationship problems, and other issues faced by many heterosexuals. The decision to stay clear of the sexual orientation issue, conveniently keeps therapeutic investigations in present-time. It also keeps therapy sessions far away from childhood, parents, and reactions to what may have been going on

at home.

- This is another example of *The Great Cover-Up* and the widespread cover-up of the frequency and tragedy of incest. However, in the case of homosexuals, it is a double tragedy helping to hide a tremendous amount of inner pain. Importantly, those primarily responsible for covering-up this double tragedy are not medical professionals. The people with the prime responsibility are gays and their parents. They know vital facts about homosexual behavior that they are selfishly and irresponsibly choosing to hide.
  
- Most medical professionals admit to not knowing what causes homosexuality or bisexuality. It homosexuality was once thought to be the result of "troubled family dynamics" or "faulty psychological development," but now they assert that those assumptions were based on "misinformation and prejudice." We challenge that assertion. If any scientific evidence exists that conclusively disproves a parent-family connection to homosexual behavior, we would be happy publish it.
  
- Recently, the primary medical thrust has been directed to searching for "biological causes" for homosexuality. Not surprisingly, there are no replicated scientific studies supporting a specific biological or genetic cause for homosexuality. On several occasions, there were widespread media reports about the discovery of a "gay gene." Those reports were later discovered to

be unfounded. However, the media failed to report this fact with the same gusto put behind the news of the false declaration. As a result, many people wrongly believe that genes cause homosexuality.

- On the upside, public opinion about homosexuals has been significantly and positively changed during the past thirty years. This positive change is due to the political activism and pressures exerted in the area of civil rights by members of the gay community and their supportive parents. For those efforts, they deserve praise. However, and unfortunately, what has happened to homosexual behavior recently is similar to what happened in the past with religious behavior.
  
- Political activism and pressures exerted by members of the gay community and their supportive parents have resulted in a "protective line" being drawn around homosexuality. Any objective and deep investigation into this obviously abnormal behavior has been officially deemed "off-limits." This is causing great harm and impeding the truth from surfacing.
  
- If our experience with homosexuals and bisexuals is consistent with other homosexuals and bisexuals, then many, if not all, are double parent incest survivors and in extreme selfish reaction to their childhood and teenage experiences at home. They are also choosing to control to an extreme and are dishonest, and in denial about their sexual past. Like a heterosexual choosing to

engage in these kinds of destructive and self-defeating activities, their choices frequently result in inner conflict, guilt, and instability.

- Many homosexuals and bisexuals have difficulty coping and being reliable. Many are plagued by intense jealousy and are driven to be promiscuous. Homosexual relationships that tend to be long-term often have infrequent sexual activity. Furthermore, like most incest survivors, they are masters at spinning false positive images, so the truth about them is rarely seen in public.
  
- Out of a sincere concern, we are choosing to cross the politically correct line that has been drawn around homosexual behavior. We will openly challenge the assertions of most gays, as well as, the currently popular medical and religious views about the nature of this sexual behavior. We do so in the best interest of homosexuals, even though we expect that many may deny our assertions or resent them.
  
- We make our challenges because numerous ideas, attitudes, and opinions are untrue, but, also, because we believe most narratives and explanations from the gay community are incomplete or calculated distortions of truth. All of these are seriously harming gay men, lesbians, and bisexuals everywhere and locking them into a life of ongoing inner conflict and pain.

- We will be presenting an abundance of information which shows that sexual experiences with parents, combined with selfish reactions and other psychological factors, are prevalent in children and teens who grow to identify as gay, lesbian, or bisexual. Our research findings are personal and family-related. It is information that we believe most homosexuals and their parents have been denying and working to keep suppressed. They strive to project images of "normality" and "stability," and keep the public and medical focus on societal issues.
  
- The gays and bisexuals with whom we closely interacted had many common experiences. They all experienced deep-rooted frustration, resentment, humiliation, insecurity, shame, and guilt. Most importantly, in time, as they came to trust us and saw that we freely offered solid explanations and practical ways for them to choose out of their reaction and pain, they spoke in great detail about having been sexually abused by both their mothers and fathers, during their growing up years living at home.
  
- The parental sexual abuse they recounted was long-term. It usually included other extreme forms of abuse, manipulation, and control. It was those hidden physical sexual experiences, along with key subconscious psychological factors and the child's selfish reactions that explained the typical attractions, repulsions, feelings, urges, drives, and behavior patterns.

- Typically, when a homosexual teen or adult comes out, it is an extremely emotionally charged and trying experience for everyone involved—especially, for the homosexual’s parents. Most parents appear to be concerned for the welfare of their gay children, supposedly because their children are choosing to openly become members of a stigmatized group.
  
- Many parents of gay children who come out publicly say that they themselves fear rejection by their own family, friends, religious, or social groups. Some parents join large organizations comprised of the families of gay men, lesbians, and bisexuals that provide information and assistance to them and their families.
  
- Fear of societal stigma and rejection may be what parents claim, however, these were not the common initial reactions we found parents of gays having. When a gay child decided to come out, his or her parents usually felt four strong reactions: betrayed, guilt, anger, and fear that their own sexual roles in their child’s behavior might be discovered. On the other hand, their gay children were mainly afraid of their parents’ possible reaction. Usually, they told their parents well after telling peers and others.
  
- A large number of gay men and women are parents. Estimates range from 1 million to 5 million lesbian

mothers. Children with a gay parent are estimated to be from 6 million to 14 million. Most of these children were conceived in heterosexual marriages. Artificial inseminations, adoptions, and foster parenting are increasing the numbers of children with gay parents.

Scientific studies indicate that the children of gay parents are as likely to be “healthy” and “well adjusted” as children who are raised in heterosexual households. Those findings make sense when one considers that the majority of children grow up in incestuous households, with at least one sexually abusive parent. That sad fact considerably lowers the bar when medical researchers use the “selfish norm” as a comparison base for determining “healthy” and “well adjusted.”

Having said that, any double-parent incest survivor is apt to be in a relatively more extreme state of sexual reaction than a typical, one parent incest survivor. That fact makes it less likely that a homosexual would be a healthy and well-adjusted parent. It is our belief that gays when they are parents, experience more destructive and reactive drives and must surmount them if they are to be loving, nurturing parents.

Of course, there are heterosexual parents who have destructive and reactive drives; unfortunately, these are being falsely attributed to genetic, brain chemical, or other biological factors, and not being properly dealt with either. []
